Ten Commandments for Concert-goers

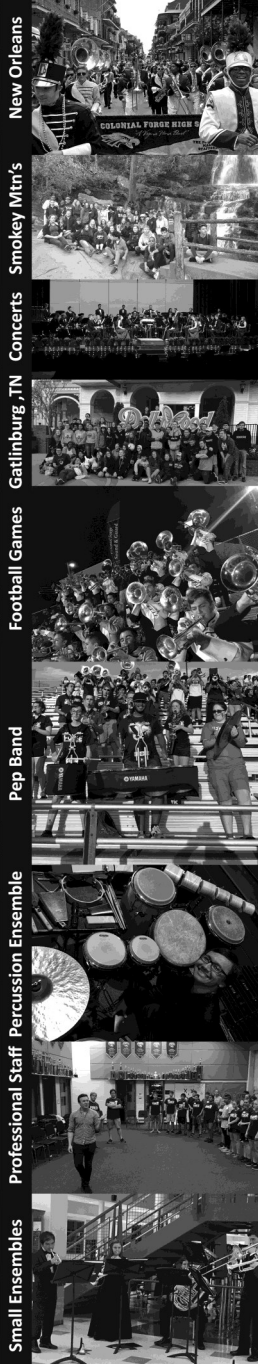
IX

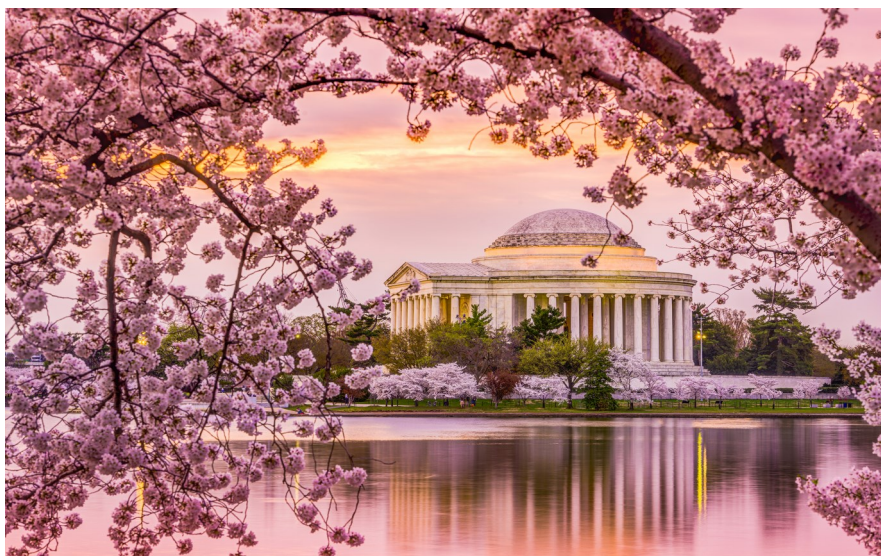
